In October 2008, the PCI (Payment Card Industry) released the PCI DSS 1.2 directives which include Wi-Fi scanning requirements. AirMobile includes automatic generation of PCI compliance reports to fulfill PCI requirements.

AirMobile can be purchased either as a monthly hosted service or as a perpetual system including AirMobile server.
